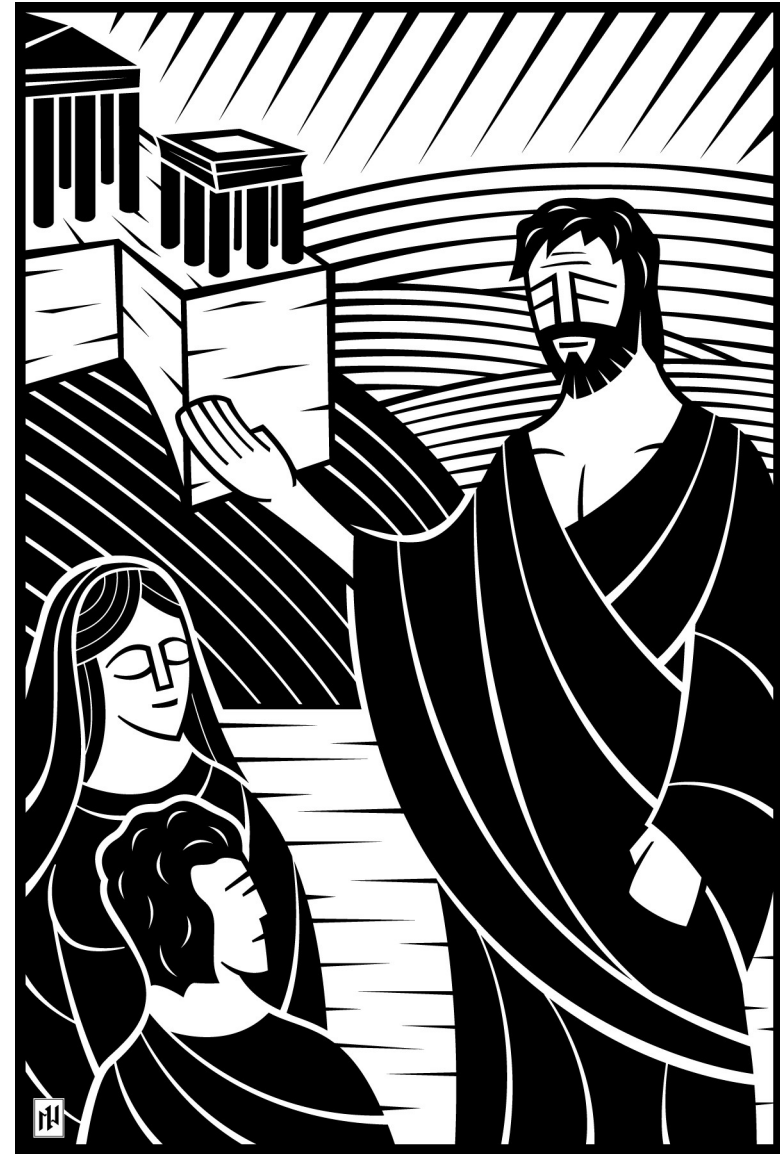

## PLEASE RESPECT OUR PRACTICE OF "CLOSE COMMUNION"

Christ says the Sacrament is an expression of unity (1Co 10:14-15). We WANT to be unified with you on the basis of Christ and His doctrine! Honesty compels us to ask you to WAIT before communing with us: 1) until you've had a chance to find out what we teach; 2) until you make your unity with us evident by membership at Peace. ## CHRIST'S DESCENT INTO HELL

Today we hear one of the two Bible passages that speak of Christ's descent into hell. Why did Christ descend into hell? 1 Peter 3 states that after he was made alive by the Spirit he *went and preached to the spirits in prison*. The only prison that can hold spirits is hell. Why would Christ preach to the spirits in hell? Colossians 2:15 tells us He *triumphed over them by the cross*. Christ's purpose in descending into hell was to demonstrate His victory over hell and its powers. If Christ is victorious over hell, so are all who trust in Christ.

## OH CHRIST, LAMB OF GOD

This song alludes to John the Baptist's words, "Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!" (John 1:29). It is combined with a prayer that has been uttered virtually for as long as there have been believers: Lord, have mercy on us! (Luke 18:13). Notice, we prayed, "Have mercy on us!" at the beginning of the service also. As we are about to receive Christ's body and blood in the Lord's Supper, this song brings us right to Golgotha, right to the atoning sacrifice of our Lord, the Lamb from God: Lord, give us the forgiveness you earned for us by your death!"
