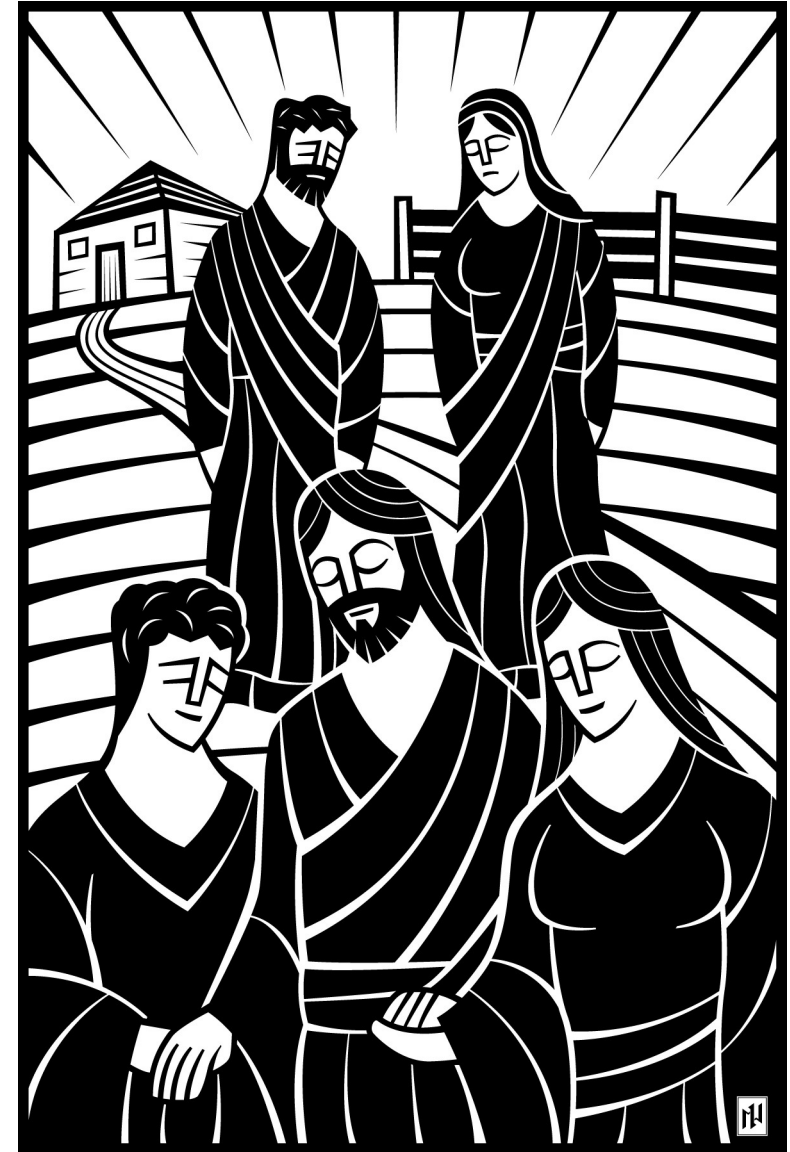

TEXT AND TUNE

For each hymn the text (or the words) and the tune are separate things. Some texts were written to fit a certain tune. Some tunes were composed specifically to carry a certain text. If you look at the bottom-left of each hymn you can see who wrote the text and who wrote the tune (and when).

THE SIGN OF THE CROSS

The pastor making the sign of the cross with his hand has no magical power. He makes this sign as a reminder of Christ's atoning sacrifice to redeem us. In particular, the sign of the cross is made when the Triune God is invoked (...and the Son...), at the Words of Institution (This is my body... this is my blood...), and during the blessing.
