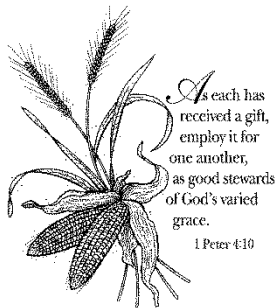
## HELP NAME OUR NEW ECLC!
